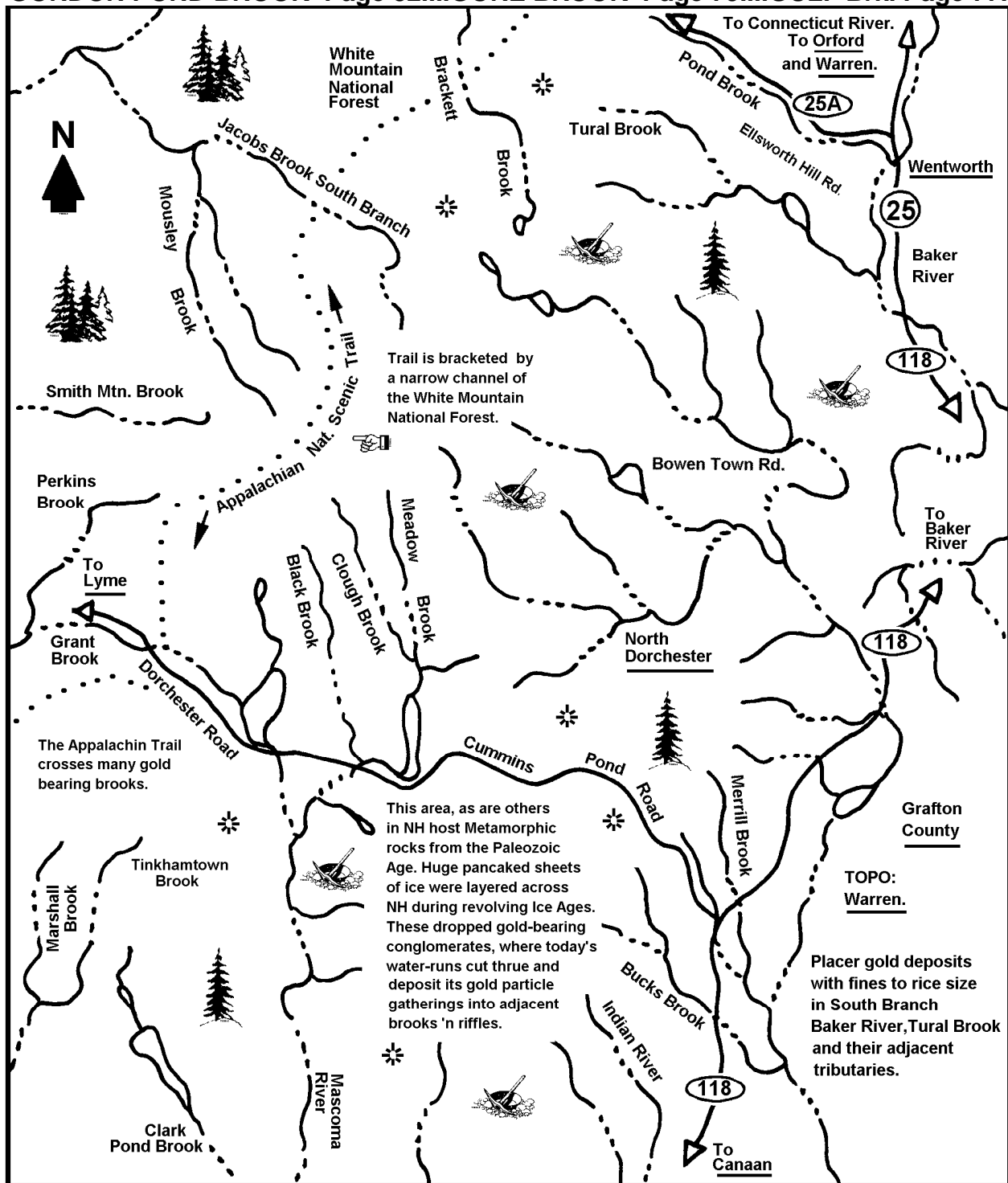

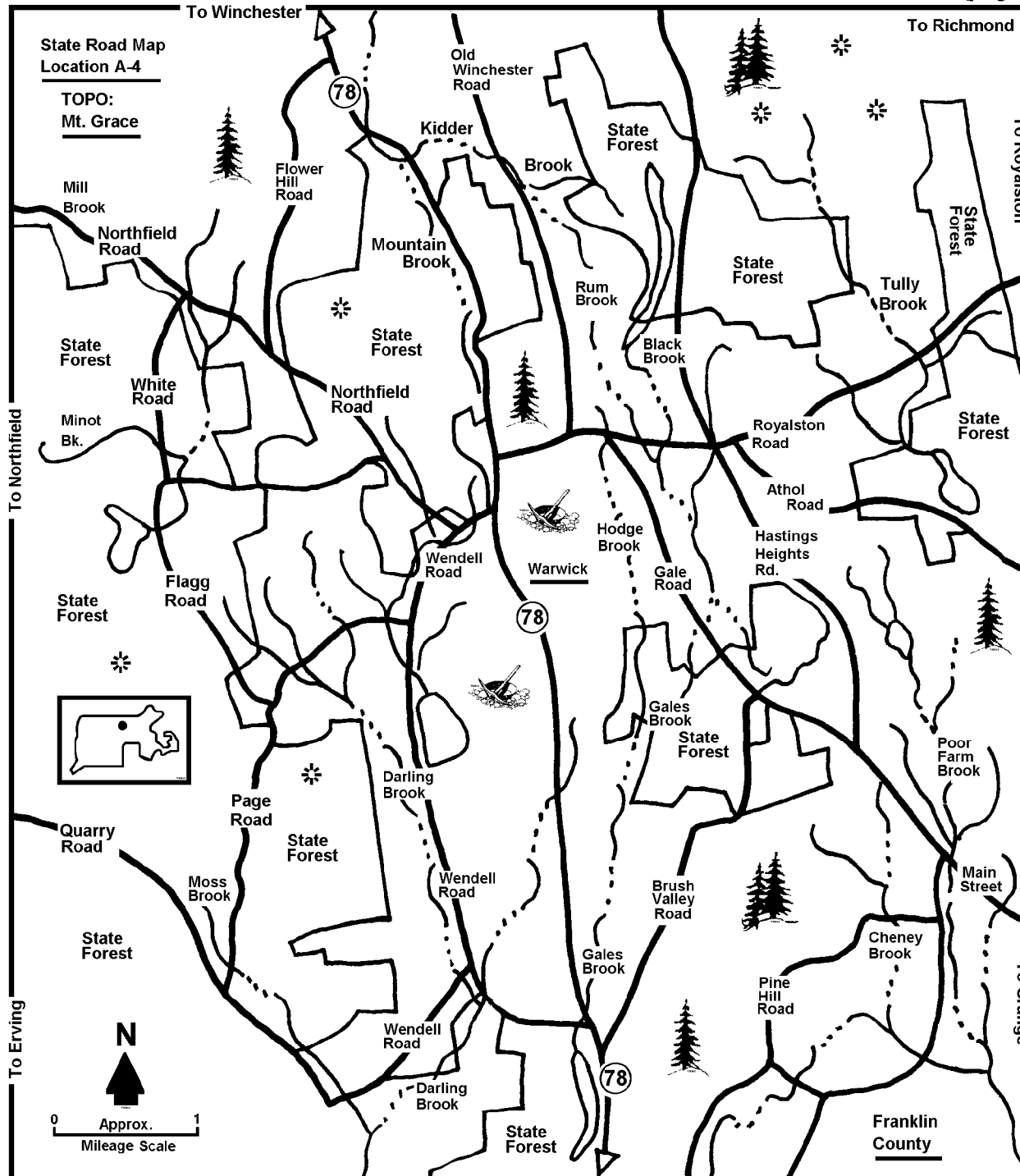

NH-19 AMALGAMATION is a gold recovery process where mercury is introduced into a water slurry of gold ore concentrates or free gold. To be 100% effective, both the gold and mercury must be clean of coatings and debris. Free gold must be cleaned with alkaline reagents.

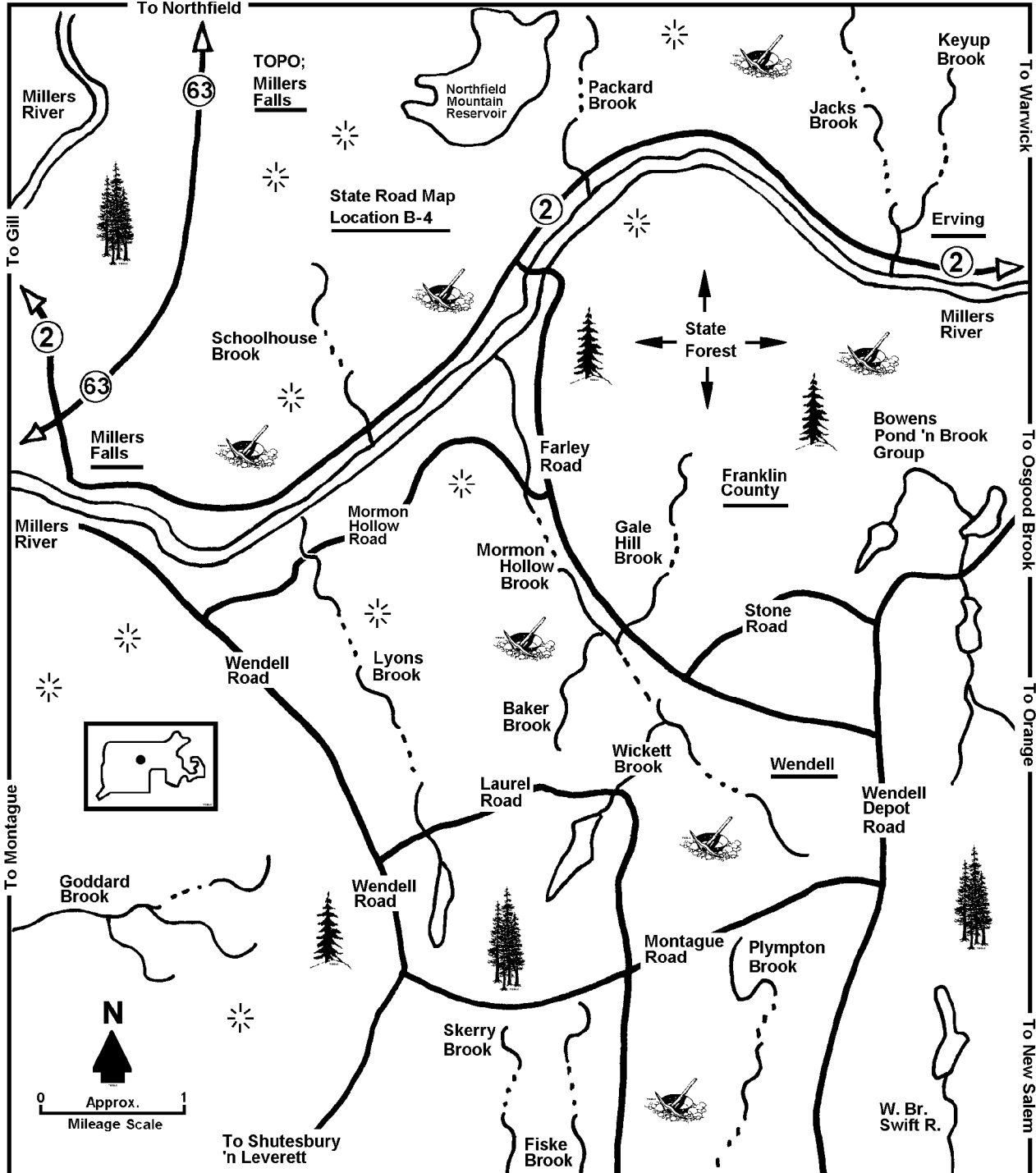

MA-20 After checking black sands (magnetite), for gold 'n platinum, the gold panner will discard the black sand concentrates into a bucket and then go over these when time allows. Alertness to quantities of rare-earth minerals of Tantalum, Titanium, Scheelite, Spine, Rutile, Zircon, Monazite and many more can be identified by chemical analysis testing or by a blacklight (ultraviolet lamp.)
